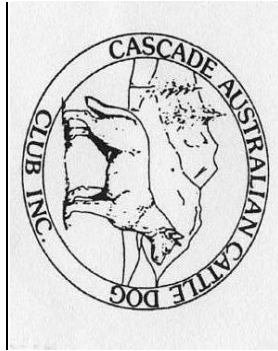

If it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
